



ATTENTION, NEW SUN CAP:

Since 2017, again the white cap that covers the sun-projection-lamp of the Baader Planetarium is made of glass. Just as it had been manufactured from opaque glass at the beginning of the production in 1966.

This new glass-cap does not clip on and off (like the white plastic-sun-cap did before), but it is now threaded onto the black center socket that holds the projection-lamp.

Please handle this glass cap with care. In case of incorrect handling or inadvertent force, there is a risk of injury by breaking the glass cover.

Also the glass of the sun cap can become hot at full brightness intensity.

So always wear Tricot-gloves when mounting or unscrewing the sun-cap. In this way you will protect yourself from heat and eventual cutting damage.
